Medical Transportation Assistance Program (MTAP) Things to KNOW before you Go

- Be sure to get a confirmation of your appointment while you are at your appointment. If an escort is required, be sure the confirmation indicates that an escort is required.
- Keep your ferry receipts OR airline ticket/s & itinerary be sure to have them issued in the name of patient or escort.
- Keep documentation if there are delays or cancellations while you travel.
- Keep your accommodation receipts. MTAP will reimburse up to \$150 per night for eligible travel with receipts. No receipts are needed to claim \$25 per night in private accommodations.
- Reimbursement for meals and mileage is calculated automatically for MTAP.
- \$80 airline vouchers are available for travel between Blanc Sablon and St. Anthony from the Labrador South Health Centre.
- MTAP provides a partial pre-payment of economy airline fares.
- And again, be sure to get a confirmation of your appointment while you are at your appointment. If an escort is required be sure the confirmation indicates that an escort is required.

Effective April 1, 2024:

 The anniversary date used to calculate a patient's travel deductible and assistance rate in a 12-month period will be set permanently as April 1 with an end date of March 31 for all program users.
